BUSINESS: ATV Routes – Roger updated. Met on 7/30 to discuss. Currently have 2 ordinances. Would like to

create 1 new ordinance opening all roads, excluding the portion of Nancy Lake road from Gruzy's to Cty Hwy I. Discussion followed. Resident asked if there could not be a sign put on Narrows Trail. Discussion followed. Jim Smith motioned to open all roads, 2nd by Harold Smith. Jim Smith amended his motion to exclude/close the section of Nancy Lake Rd from Gruzy's to Cty Hwy I and to rescind the old ATV

ordinances 7 and 12, 2nd by Harold Smith. 4 ayes, 1 nay. Motion Carried.

<u>Grader Prices –</u> Larry updated on the quotes that have come in so far. Board discussed our new insurance carrier enrolled us in the Farmers Union which offers a discount on John Deere. The board

asked Susan to look into the discount amount.

Transfer Station- Chairman gave report stating there were 9 loads in June. Total collected YTD is

\$19,692. \$2012 behind this time last year.

Constable- Eric was present. The security cameras we have are very important and useful. It caught a truck on camera which is believed to have torn up the yard at Bass Lake Park and also some parking lot spots at the shop. The power of social media is huge, he posted it to the Village Police page and has already had great feedback of people seeing this truck. He told residents to not be afraid to use cameras at their homes for security and also expressed again "If you see anything suspicious in your area, please call it in". There have been break-ins again, but they don't believe its kids messing around based on the kinds of things that are being taken. The scrap yard on Narrows Trail has been informed they cannot run this kind of a business there. There is not a new warden yet but the county does have a Recreational Officer that will handle more ATV type issues. As of now, he's working more M-F. If you are noticing any issues, still call even if it's a weekend.

<u>Lakes Committee</u>- Member was present and updated. The 4 different weekend educational sessions are now done, there wasn't a large turnout but it all went fine. Boat monitoring will be extended past Labor Day to make up for rain days. They need to get all their hours in so the this can continue in the future.

<u>Clerk's Update-</u> Susan updated. Susan Alicia went to school in Green Bay for a week in July. Susan finished up the clerk side of school and Alicia started her first year for the treasures track. Susan received a \$700 scholarship which helped with a large portion of her school cost this year.
