


Farmers to Families Food Boxes

Farmers to Families Food Box

USDA is partnering with farmers, ranchers, specialty crop producers, food processors and distributors, and non-profit organizations to ensure that all Americans have access to the fresh and wholesome food they need during the COVID-19 national emergency.



Farmers

sell food previously destined for restaurants and bulk purchasers to distributors, preventing waste

Distributors

partner with USDA to package family-sized boxes with fresh produce, dairy and meat products, then transport them to non-profits across America

Families

pick up food boxes from local schools, food banks, faith-based organizations and other non-profits

When: 10/21/2020 and 10/28/2020 at 10:00AM until 2:00PM or until food (1,200 boxes each day) is gone.

Where: Washburn County Hwy Department, 1600 County Highway H, Spooner, WI 54801

Who is eligible: Anyone and Everyone! There is no income or local zip code required! Just pop your trunk!

Why? COVID-19 has been hard on everyone, so, instead of farmers throwing their crops and other products away The United States Department of Agriculture has partnered with farmers to bring their high quality products to communities in need of assistance. On October 21 and 28, the last two Wednesdays of the month, you will be able to pick up a FREE box that contains 5-6 pounds of fresh produce, some dairy products like cheese and yogurt, some different types of proteins and a gallon of milk!
