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## 2021 - 2022 Minong Flowage Winter Drawdown 2nd Notice

Start Date: September 20, 2021

Drawdown rate not to exceed 2 inches a day

In accordance with the existing Minong Flowage Lake Management Plan, results from the 2020 late summer plant survey and the 2021 spring Eurasian Water Milfoil (EWM) survey, and discussion with the Wisconsin DNR and Washburn County Highway Department, plans are proceeding to drawdown the Flowage this winter to control the spread of EWM. The drawdown will begin on September 20 and proceed at a rate not to exceed 2 inches a day. The drawdown will be a maximum 60 inches and is to be reached no later than November 1 per request from the DNR. The water level will start to be returned to normal levels once ice melt has started and ice has receded from shorelines and exposed stumps and logs. It is anticipated to be at normal levels by the 2022 fishing season opener.

Please plan accordingly regarding care of your boats and shoreline equipment as once the water begins to recede it will be difficult or impossible to remove your watercraft from the flowage.
