## TOWN OF MINONG MINONG POLICE DEPARTMENT ORDINANCE 2024-12

The Town Board of the Town of Minong does ordain as follows:

## **SECTION I – JURISDICTION AND DUTIES**

The Minong Police Department shall:

- 1. Familiarize themselves with the ordinances of the Town of Minong and the state statutes and attend to the enforcement of such ordinances by all lawful means.
- 2. Help prevent crimes, misdemeanors and violations of Town ordinances and protect the health, safety, public peace and order of the village and its inhabitants.
- 3. Maintain order at the scene of a fire or any other fire response within the town.
- 4. See that the necessary permits and licenses issued by the state or town are in the possession of or properly displayed by any person engaged in an activity or business within the town for which such permit or license is required and that the terms of such permits or licenses are complied with.
- 5. Perform such other lawful duties as ordered by the chief of police or their authorized representative.

## **SECTION VII – SEVERABILITY**

The provisions of the Ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Town of Minong Board would have passed the other provisions of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provision may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.

This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication as provided by law, and shall repeal and replace all previous Minong police department ordinances heretofore enacted by the Town of Minong.
